International Work – Siem Reap Cambodia .

We are always proud of the work we do ensuring that all of our pupils are local and global citizens. As you know we have worked in Sierra Leone and Cambodia over the last few years, supporting these schools in developing their provision and more recently we have linked the work to sustainability and farming. A group of staff from school will be heading over to Siem Reap in Easter to work at the school we link with there. The school is by a rubbish dump and most children work the dump every evening after school for money. Staff are heading over to continue with developing their land/ raised beds/ ponds so that the school can grow produce to sell to fund their teachers.

On Friday 23rd March we will be having a Cambodian day and would like all the pupils to come in wearing red or blue, and we are asking for donations of a pencil case with pens, and pencils in, highlighters, felt pens or other stationary items as these are things that the children there do not have.

Whilst the staff are over there, it is the Khmer New Year so we will be taking small party bags for the pupils. If your child would like to bring in a small gift for the party bags that would be great.

We will obviously be taking photos and recordings of all we are doing to share with our children and it is always good for our children to know how fortunate they are!
